### Residential Dining Behavior Standards

Saint Peter's Dining Services is an extension of the University. All patrons and guests are required to abide by all University policies and campus regulations. To ensure a pleasant and enjoyable dining experience, we ask your cooperation in observing the guidelines below. Saint Peter's Dining Services reserves the right to refuse admission or ask you to leave the premises in the event these guidelines are not followed. - Appropriate dress including shirt and shoes are required at all times.
- Upon entering the dining room, you are required to present your One Card to Dining Services staff member. Lost or defective cards must be replaced before entering the dining hall.
- Your One Card may only be used for one meal swipe by the person who is the owner of the One Card for that particular meal period. Guest swipes may be used for additional persons up to the maximum allowance permitted by that plan.
- Use of the One Card by other persons is prohibited. Loaning or misusing the One Card may cause the card to be confiscated and disciplinary action to be taken.
- No food or equipment is allowed out of the dining room with the exception of the following:  
cookies (2), dessert item in disposable container (1), an ice cream cone/cup (1), or a piece of hand fruit (1) per meal.
- Personal cups, containers or bags may not be brought into the dining room for the purpose of carrying out food or beverages of any type. Containers that are purchased or provided by Saint Peter's Dining Services for carry out purpose are the only containers permitted to be used to take food/beverages out of the dining room. This policy will be strictly enforced.
- Food that is not provided by Saint Peter's Dining Services is prohibited from the dining room. You may use the retail dining space and its microwave for all items that are from outside the University.
- Dining Services staff reserves the right to charge for any food or beverage items that are added to your outside meal from the dining room selection.
- Disruptive, disrespectful, and inappropriate behavior or language is prohibited. Failure to comply with dining services staff may result in a disciplinary referral and removal from the dining facility without a refund.
- Vandalism or theft of dishware, silverware, service ware or other university property from the dining room is prohibited and disciplinary action will follow according to university policy.
- Food or beverages are not to be thrown under any circumstances.
- Each patron is responsible for cleaning/clearing their table and placing garbage, dinnerware and silverware in the appropriate facilities.
- Saint Peter's Dining Services is not responsible for lost items. All items found are turned into Campus Security within 24 hours.
- Students are required to abide by all University policies. This includes policies related to alcohol, drugs, disruptive behavior, facility use, and prohibited items.
- Skateboards, hover boards, and rollerblades are prohibited in the Student Center which includes dining areas.

\* Examples are illustrative rather than exhaustive. Any item that may be hazardous to the community may be added to the list at any time. It is your responsibility to be in compliance.
